

**CITY OF DOVER  
ORDINANCE NO. 121**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND AN ATTENDANCE POLICY FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO:**

**SECTION 1. MAYOR AND COUNCIL SALARIES.**

Commencing January 1, 2012, the salaries of the Mayor and of the members of the Dover City Council shall be as follows:

- (a) The Mayor shall receive a monthly salary in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500); and
- (b) Each member of the Council shall receive a monthly salary in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250).

**SECTION 2. DUTY OF ELECTED OFFICIALS**

The City Council hereby acknowledges that it is the duty of all elected officials to attend all City Council Meetings of the City. For purposes of this section, Meetings shall include regular and special meetings, public hearings, workshops and work sessions duly called and noticed during the Fiscal Year. The Fiscal Year runs from October 1 to September 30 of each year.

**SECTION 3. FAILURE TO PERFORM DUTIES**

1. If an elected official is unable to attend a Meeting, that official shall notify the City Clerk at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting date that he or she will not be in attendance at the Meeting. Failure to notify the City Clerk as herein provided will result in a forfeiture of half the elected official's monthly salary for that month that a Meeting is missed.
2. In the event of an emergency that prohibits an elected official from attending a meeting and/or providing the requisite notice, the elected official is required to provide notice to the City Clerk as soon as reasonably possible.

**SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS.**

All Ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
