

RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY RESOLUTION #11

FOR THE CITY OF DOVER

WHEREAS, the City of Dover recognizes the need to manage public funds prudently and further recognizes that local government, with its range of services, is considered a high-risk operation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dover is dedicated to managing the risks, providing services to its citizens and will do all it can to prevent losses and create a safe workplace for employees. Recognizing that losses will inevitably occur, the City of Dover considers no losses acceptable and will make every effort to identify and treat all loss exposures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dover has designated a Risk Manager who is empowered to make recommendations concerning all operations of the City of Dover that affect the safety and well being of the employees of the City of Dover, its elected officials and the citizens and financial well being of the City of Dover.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the administration of the Risk Management Policy and the supervision of loss prevention activities will be under the direction of the Risk Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, every elected official and employee will adhere to the policies and practices established pertaining to risk management and loss prevention. All elected officials, department directors and employees of the City of Dover are responsible to employ safe work practices and to identify unsafe conditions while performing their daily tasks and to report those unsafe conditions to the Risk Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Risk Management Policy of the City of Dover will have the ultimate objective of preservation of this public entity's assets. As a means to that end, the Risk Manager has the responsibility of formulating and implementing programs and procedures that will minimize the public entity's property, revenue, and personnel losses.

The motion carried.


