RESOLUTION NO. 36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING A PERMITTING FEE SCHEDULE ASSOCIATED ADOPTED BUILDING CODES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Legislature required the adoption of certain building codes as identified at § 39-4116; and

WHEREAS, duly adopted Ordinance Number 64 adopted certain building codes and provided for the City Council to establish by resolution permitting fees associated with administering and enforcing such codes; and

WHEREAS, said fees to be established by this resolution are less than or equal to previously established fees and, therefore, according to provisions contained at § 63-1311A Idaho Code, require no advertisement or public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dover, County of Bonner, State of Idaho, that:

Effective January 10, 2003 the permitting fee schedule for permits issued in accordance with Ordinance Number 64 be as follows:


1. Section 107, "Fees,"/Table 1-A out of the Uniform Building Code, 1994 Edition, in conjunction with Building Valuation Data, established April 2001, of the Building Standards, published by the International Conference of Building Officials. The Building Valuation Data shall be used in determining total valuation for the application of the Building Permit Fees.
2. Table 1-A, Mechanical Permit Fees, of the Uniform Mechanical Code, 1997 Edition.
3. The fee for plan review shall be sixty-five (65%) percent of the building permit fee.
4. In determining total valuation of a project for the application of the Building Permit Fees, the valuation for decks shall be \$6.00 per square foot.
5. The fee to approve the placement of a modular home shall be \$60.00.
6. The fee to approve the placement of a commercial coach shall be \$60.00.

7. The valuation for a change of use and/or remodel shall be based upon the contractor's valuation of the project.
