RESOLUTION NO. 46

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING AN EQUITY BUY-IN VALUE FOR FUTURE WASTEWATER CONNECTION FEES TO THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, improvements to the wastewater treatment plant have been made; and

WHEREAS, duly approved funding for the construction of said treatment plant, requires establishing utility fees capable of supporting operations, maintenance and debt repayment; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 104 establishes provisions for calculating and assessing various wastewater facility charges; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, at a duly noticed regular meeting on April 15, 2008, considered calculations dated February 19, 2008 from the City Engineer regarding establishing an equity buy-in value for future wastewater connections to the wastewater treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed Public Hearing on May 13, 2008, for citizen comment regarding the new equity buy-in value for future wastewater connections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

Effective June 1, 2008 the equity buy-in value for each wastewater connection is hereby set at Eight Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Seven and 75/100 Dollars (\$8,557.75).

Upon suspension of the rules and a motion and a second to approve the foregoing Resolution, the following vote was recorded:


