**RESOLUTION NO. 48**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, SETTING FEES FOR ANY SPECIAL EVENT WITHIN THE DOVER CITY LIMITS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the City to regulate special events within Dover City Limits to promote and protect the health, safety and general welfare of its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No.106 establishes provisions for regulating special events within Dover City Limits and for City Council to set permitting fees for said special events by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a Public Hearing on May 13, 2008 to hear comments on the proposed special event fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

The Permitting Fee Schedule for Special Event Permits issued in accordance with Ordinance No. 106 be as follows:


a.	Basic Permit Fee	\$ 100.00	
b.	Extended Permit Fee	\$ 100.00	for every 100 people after 200
c.	Traveling Event Permit Fee	\$ 200.00	(i.e. parade, track meet, etc.)
d.	Vendors Permit Fee	\$ 10.00	per day
e.	Alcoholic Beverage Catering Permit Fee	\$ 20.00	per day
f.	Fireworks Permit Fee	\$ 50.00	
g.	Damage Deposit	\$ 250.00	
h.	Cleaning Deposit	\$ 200.00
