

2014 RESOLUTION 101

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR MEDICAL INSURANCE OPTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED/APPOINTED OFFICIALS; TERMINATING RESOLUTION 95 AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Dover will continue to offer health insurance coverage to eligible full time employees and elected/appointed officials; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined the City will continue to provide health coverage to eligible full time employees and elected/appointed officials; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined the City will provide **MEDICAL INSURANCE OPTIONS** for those eligible full time employees and elected/appointed officials; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that not all eligible employees and elected/appointed officials will choose health insurance coverage from the City of Dover.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

EFFECTIVE October 1, 2014 any eligible full time employee and elected/appointed official shall have the option of limited reimbursement for medical coverage purchased directly by the employee or elected/appointed official.

1. Limited Reimbursement for premiums paid by the employee or elected/appointed official towards his/her own medical insurance up to \$200 per month with verification of coverage;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho that the option of Health Insurance Coverage or Reimbursement by the eligible employee or elected/appointed official be adopted.

PASSED by the City Council and **APPROVED** by the Mayor this 23rd day of October 2014.
